The crisis situation in 2020 was the most extreme we have ever experienced in our 34 years of history. **At our food bank, and everywhere in our environment, COVID was the determining factor in our work. Right from the start, with alarm bells ringing as we urgently implemented all the health measures for our staff, the Banc dels Aliments reinvented itself to adapt to the new situation.**

With a sense of disbelief and unaware of the possible impacts of such a pandemic, the first reality was the exponential increase in the demand for food, directly linked to the increase in poverty. The agreed response was to always say YES to everyone. This resulted in a huge drop in the ratio of kilos/person/month that was being distributed at the beginning of the year, falling from 14.5 kilos/person/month to 7 kilos, causing great concern at the Banc dels Aliments (BdA).

Through the media the business world and Catalan society as a whole became aware of the BdA's efforts to obtain food. Their response was immediate, and from April onwards the food bank

received a steady flow of donations. Thanks to this generosity we were able to buy basic food-stuffs and to increase the ratio of kilos distributed per beneficiary, which is an indisputable indicator of our actions.

I am particularly pleased to note that, this year again, **civil society showed its unconditional support for our organisation by participating massively in the Gran Recapte.** Organising it this year was the biggest challenge for us in the 13 years of the campaign.

The pandemic disrupted a model that had worked very well for 12 editions. In this 13th edition the BdA was forced to switch to a new donation format. Monetary donations to buy food replaced the physical food donations we were used to.

Despite the difficulty of conveying the message, the public understood the situation we were in and, after many months of confinement, surprised us once again with a response that far exceeded the success of the previous edition. Thanks again to all of you!

In addition to the generosity and solidarity of all these actors, we also had help from the administration. In the last quarter we received a substantial grant from the Generalitat de Catalunya that enabled us to plan the purchase of food which, together with the food collected during the Gran Recapte, will allow us to work with more peace of mind at the beginning of this new year.

As you will see in this report, this year's figures are extraordinary, **but behind these spectacular figures is the most important one: the 216 people who make up the Banc dels Aliments – the volunteers and our excellent professional team.**

Our volunteers have always been our strength, and now more than ever I feel immensely proud of the dedication of this great supportive family. A family that

has not faltered for a moment in its determination to get food to those who need it most and who have worked tirelessly from Monday to Sunday to keep the BdA's operations going at all times. We know that not all heroes wear capes, sometimes they wear volunteer vests.

Finally, a special thanks to all of society, to companies and the Generalitat, who support us year after year with total confidence in our **SOLIDARITY AND SUSTAINABILITY** project. And I hope to be able to count on you all in 2021. It's likely to be a challenging year, but we're ready to take it on, stronger and more determined than ever.

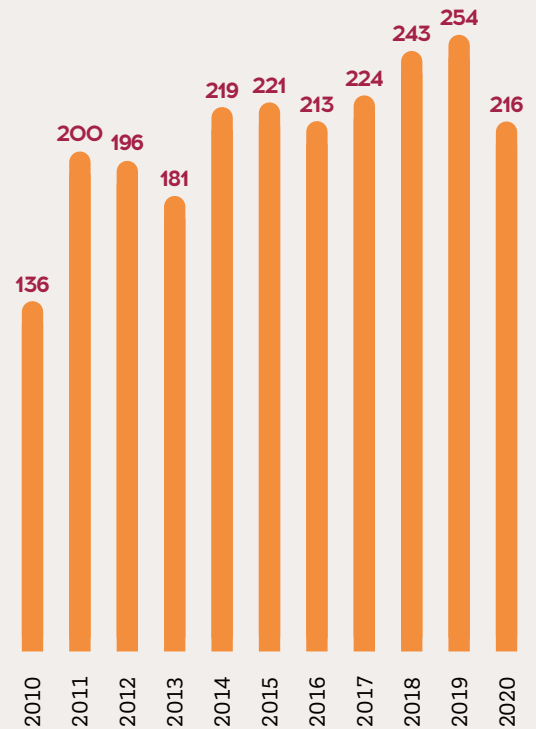

# Right to food

## DISTRIBUTION DEPARTMENT AND LIAISON WITH ENTITIES

The outbreak of the COVID pandemic posed an unprecedented challenge for the Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona. The main objective in recent months has been to work in coordination with social organisations in order to respond to the huge increase in the demand for food.

The food distribution model provides access to food aid for as long as the right to food is not guaranteed for all citizens. This model is based on five principles:

**“We carry out our mission by working in a network with social initiative organisations and in coordination with the social services of the administrations.”**



### Free of charge

Distributing the food free of charge means that some of the scarce economic resources available to people in a situation of vulnerability can be used to pay for other basic needs.



### Efficient

We monitor, support and give advice to recipient entities, foster networking between the entities and connect them with municipal social services. We promote entity associations, regulatory warehouses and the free food-choice model. During the months of confinement, we responded promptly and agilely to the urgent requests we received from 90 entities, associations and support networks, which represented a 40% increase in demand.



### Equitable

Food is distributed through seven different distribution programmes according to the type and origin of the food, applying different distribution criteria and taking into account the number of people assisted who have been referred by social services. Distribution is carried out equitably to ensure that the beneficiaries receive a similar quantity and variety of food.



### Sustainable

Coordination of shared transport to reduce the carbon footprint. We channel local collections by linking donations of surplus food from markets, supermarkets and restaurants with the entities, based on their geographical proximity. The virtual format of the 2020 Gran Recapte campaign allowed us to minimise the logistical distribution of the more than 3,500 tonnes collected in the Barcelona area.



### Inclusion

Of the total number of recipient entities that receive food, 60% also carry out accompanying measures, providing guidance and advice for socio-occupational inclusion. We promote a free-choice food distribution model to ensure dignified food distribution. Our distribution model generates indirect employment in logistics, transport, administration and the social sector. It also fosters citizen participation through volunteering. This year, for the first time, part of the funds raised during the Gran Recapte campaign were converted into wallet cards which allowed beneficiaries to buy basic foodstuffs according to their needs and preferences.



## We provide support

- By offering advice on free food-choice models and how to group entities. Assisting with logistics and stock management.
- Providing educational material about food safety protocols.
- Helping with the application procedure for joining the different distribution programmes we offer.
- Purchasing and lending cold storage equipment to the recipient entities so that they can join the Cold Chain programme (freezers and refrigerators).
- Providing isothermal bags for transporting chilled or frozen products.
- Transport support for entities belonging to the network of recipient entities.
- Storage support.

## We promote

- Territorial working groups, with periodic meetings between the different agents.
- Entity-grouping and free food-choice.
- Territorial regulatory warehouses to optimise logistics.

## We share knowledge

- We monitor, support and offer advice to recipient entities.
- Provide teaching material on food safety and nutrition.
- Offer training workshops on nutrition.
- Share good practices and experiences.

**Food banks** have been present in Europe for over **thirty-five years**, with the aim of reducing food waste by making use of surplus food, and combating food insecurity by distributing food to those in need, thus helping to **ensure access to sufficient, safe and nutritious food**. It is estimated that **20% of the food produced in Europe is wasted**, and that **33 million people are currently at risk of food insecurity**. The **Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona was founded in 1987** and, from the beginning, its activity has been based on **two pillars: sustainability**, aiming to recover as much food as possible each day; and **solidarity**, helping to guarantee the right to food for everyone in our environment.

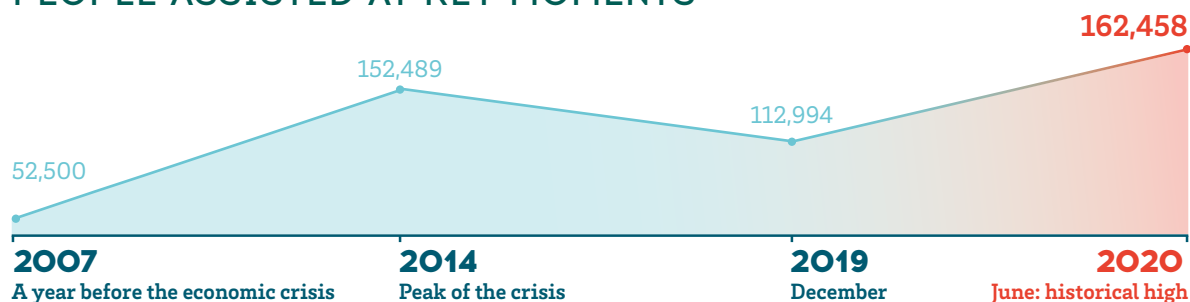

## PEOPLE ASSISTED AT KEY MOMENTS



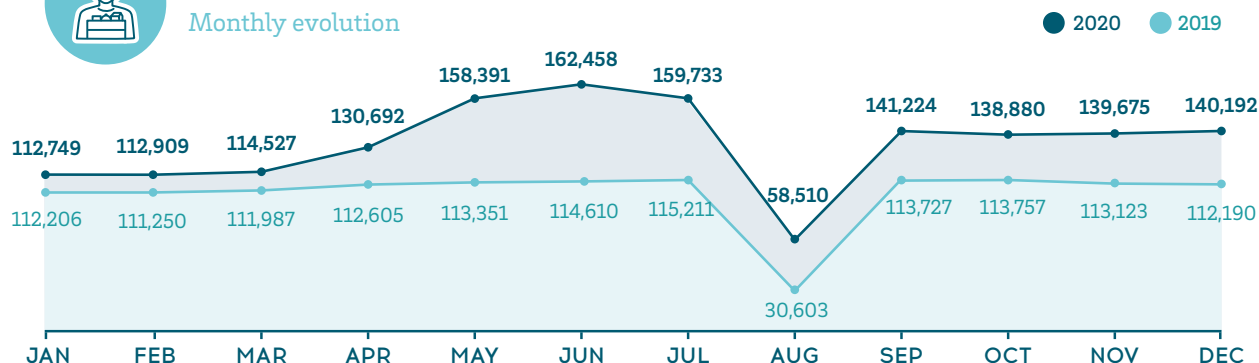

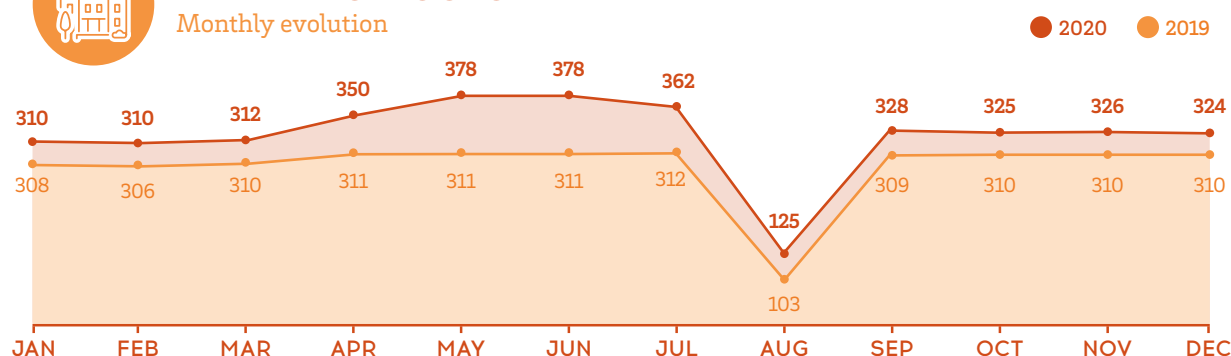
## PEOPLE ASSISTED

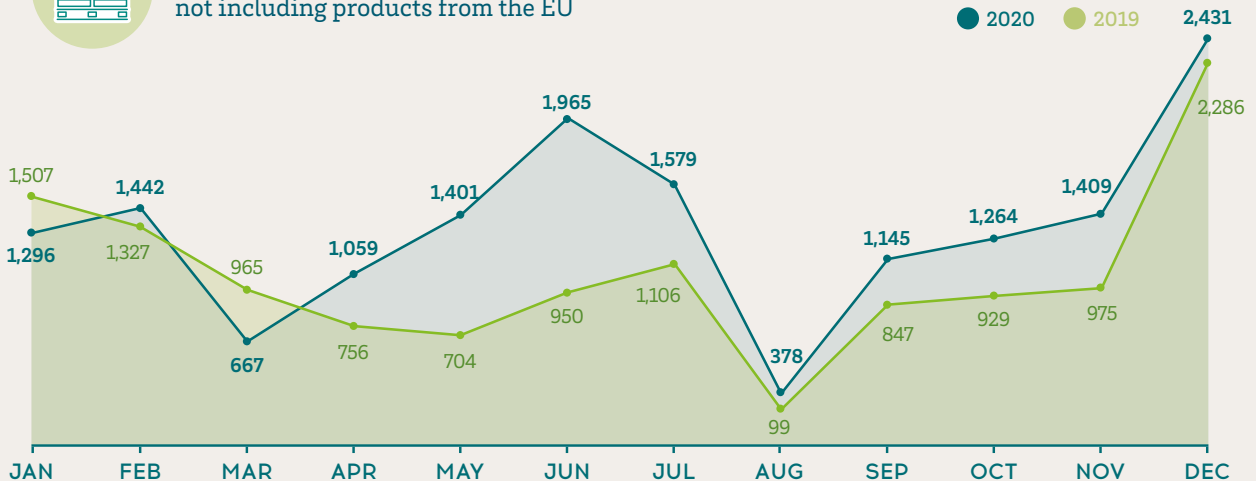

# Gran Recapte

## EVEN GREATER PUBLIC SOLIDARITY THAN BEFORE

The **12th edition of the Gran Recapte d'Aliments** (Food Collection campaign), which ran in November and December, was **clearly marked by the pandemic**. The traditional format of physical food donations had to be replaced with financial donations, which were then used to buy the food. The public understood the reasons for the change of format **and once again collaborated on a massive scale**.

The advantage of this new format is that it allows us to buy the food that is needed most at any given time, which ensures a sustained distribution of basic food products and optimises the logistics of the campaign.

A total of **5,501,720 euros** was donated in the Barcelona area, equivalent to **3,526,744 kilos** of food purchased, which was an increase of **524,744 kilos (17.5%)** on the previous year.

In Catalonia as a whole, the Gran Recapte campaign raised a total of **7,851,707 euros** in donations, equivalent to around **5 million kilos of food, 12% more than in the previous edition**.

Once again, all this was possible thanks to the help of the **7,228 volunteers**. Instead of filling the large 'bins' with food, they became disseminators for the food banks, explaining the new campaign format to the public.

**The Gran Recapte campaign is a great boost for the food banks** as it helps them to meet part of the significant increase in demand as a result of COVID.

In addition to virtual donations in food establishments, **online donations** were also promoted on the campaign's website **www.granrecapteonline.com** and new payment methods such as **BIZUM** were incorporated. With regard to in-store donations, there was a significant increase in the number of small shops and municipal markets who participated in this edition. These, together with the usual supermarket chains, amounted to 3,555 donation points.



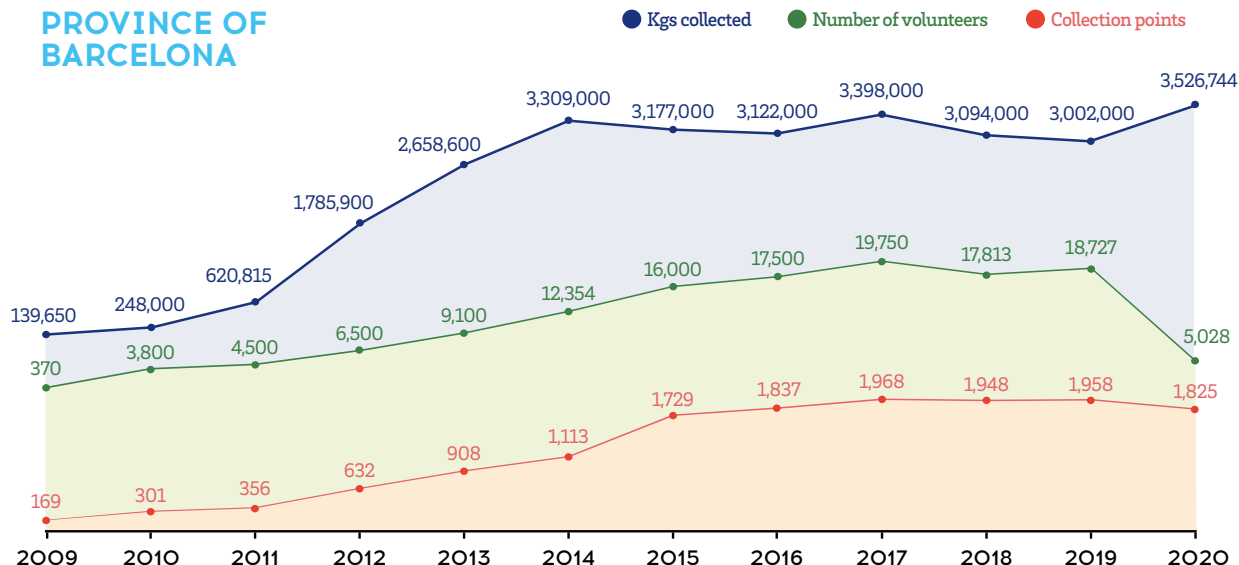

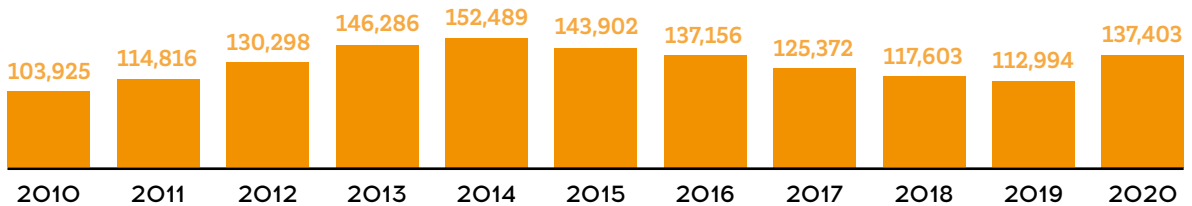






## EVOLUTION OF PEOPLE ASSISTED PER MONTH

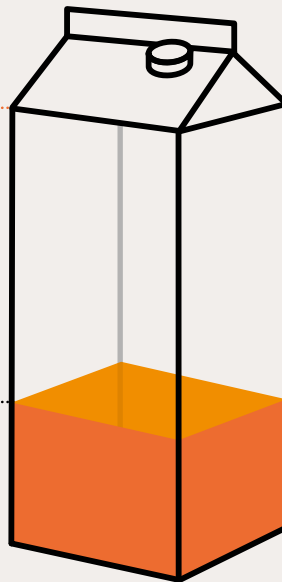

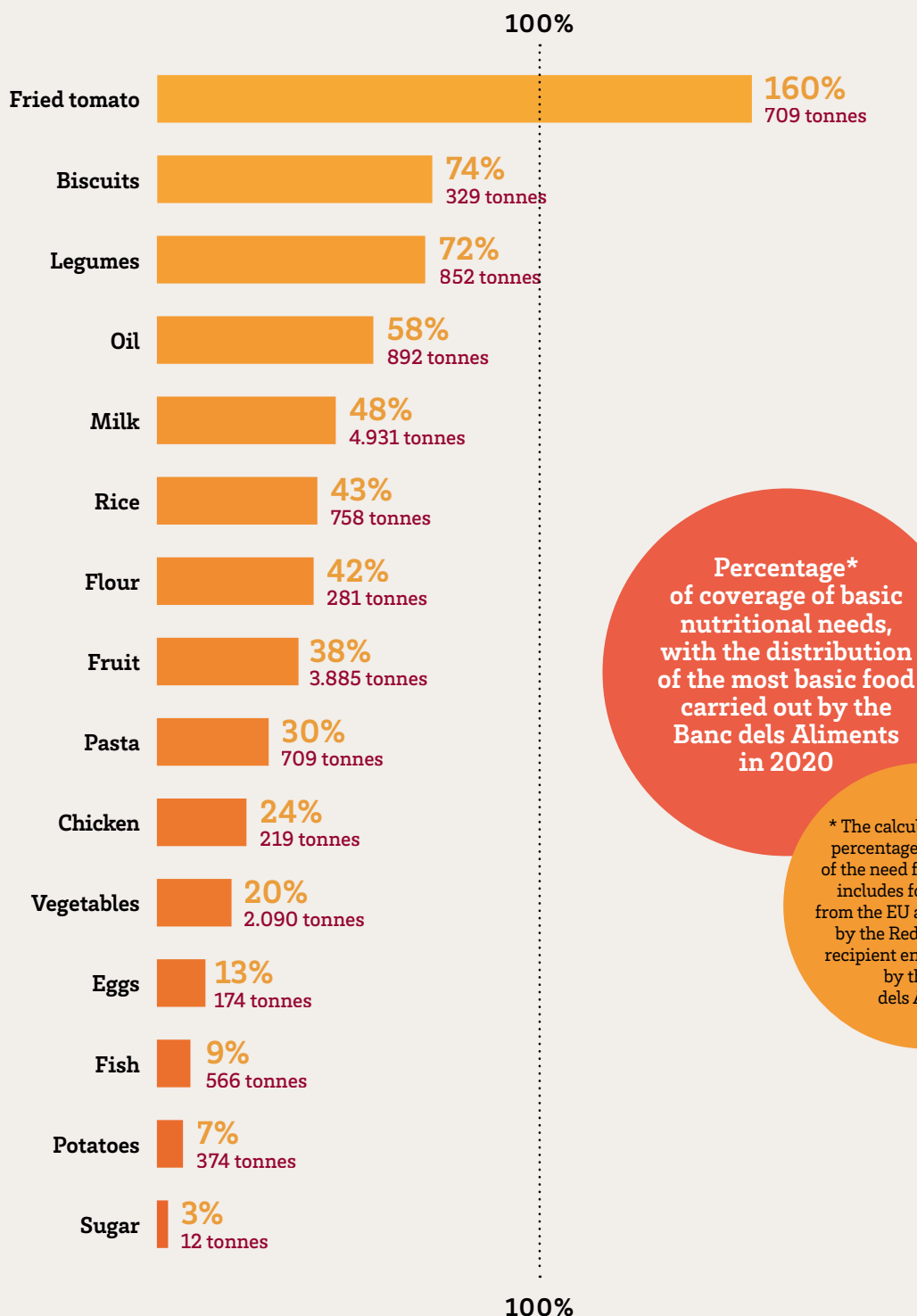

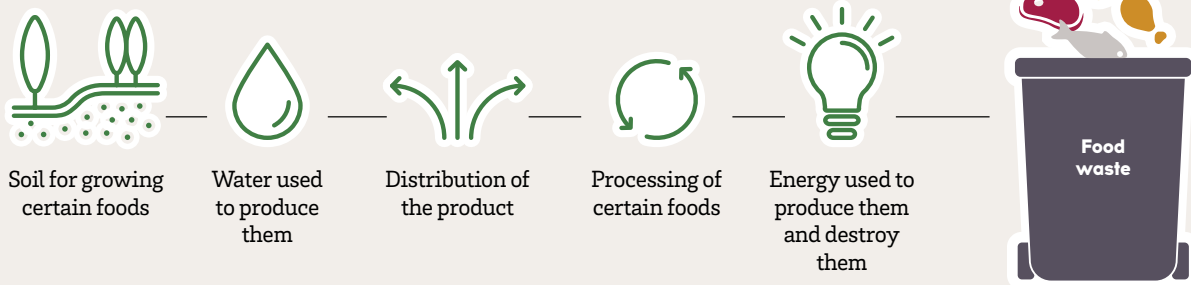

# Equipment and logistics

## CARRER DELS MOTORS

All tasks carried out in the warehouse at the headquarters are undertaken by some **60 volunteers** who rotate weekly and support **4** salaried staff and **2** temporary workers. Each day, another **5** people on average carry out work to benefit the community (community service workers), who provide their services through an agreement with the Justice Department of the Generalitat.

With the outbreak of COVID, the **Logistics department** had to react quickly in order to adapt to the restrictions and health regulations and to be able to guarantee the distribution of food. The older volunteers were relieved by **400 new volunteers** who came to help out during the lockdown period. Of these, **250** worked on a regular basis between March and August and around **20** continue to be involved with the Banc dels Aliments.

Thanks to the public's offer to help, the **Banc dels Aliments** was able to continue its logistical work at full capacity and to **respond efficiently to the demand for food**.

# Highlights

## COLLABORATION AGREEMENT WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA



At the end of 2020, the **Govern de la Generalitat** (Government of Catalonia), through the **Department of Labour, Social Affairs and Families**, signed a collaboration agreement with the four Catalan food banks to allocate around **3.3 million euros** to **guarantee the right to sufficient, necessary and nutritious food** and to avoid other more serious situations of risk. This amount will be used in 2021 to purchase and distribute food to cover the basic needs of families in a situation of economic precariousness that has arisen or worsened as a result of the pandemic.

## COVID VOLUNTEERS

Relief in the warehouse, volunteers working remotely and an increased workforce



The arrival of the pandemic meant that the BdA had to completely reorganise its operations. Safety protocols were implemented with regard to working in the facilities and, following the recommendations of the Catalan Food Safety Agency, with regard to handling the foodstuffs. A large part of the permanent volunteers started to work remotely, while new volunteers were brought in to carry out warehouse tasks and to relieve the older volunteers. The staff was also increased, with new workers hired to speed up the entry and exit of food.

## MASSIVE RESPONSE FROM THE PUBLIC

In this particularly difficult year, the collaboration of the public was, as always, commendable. Society's response to the BdA's calls for help was extraordinary in the campaigns launched to deal with the **COVID emergency**, which ran in March, April and May, and also in the **Gran Recapte** in November and December. The Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona managed to raise **€9.6 million euros thanks to public donations**:

- Gran Recapte: **€5,500,000** (details on page 12)
- COVID emergency campaigns: **+ €2,600,000**
- Donations through traditional channels: **+ €1,500,000**

This all adds up to a **record amount raised**, which is helping us to cope with the significant increase in the number of people requesting food as a result of the social crisis.

Of the 9.6 million euros raised, almost 6 million have been received into our bank accounts and are included in the operating accounts for 2020. The remaining 3.6 million is an open credit we have with supermarkets and will be used to supply us in the early months of 2021. This amount will be reflected in the operating accounts for 2021, but it is also included in the 2020 annual accounts.



## INCREASE IN CORPORATE DONATIONS

The social crisis resulting from the pandemic generated a great show of corporate solidarity and support. Hundreds of companies from the agri-food sector, but also from other sectors, donated food, money, materials, resources and services.

Dry food such as pasta, oil and baby food; fruit and vegetables from **MERCABARNA**, via the **DARP** programme; surplus food of high nutritional value **from the catering and hospitality sector**, affected by the stoppage of their activity, helped us to restock our warehouse and to cope with the sudden increase in demand during the first weeks of the lockdown.

Many companies provided us with PPE materials (masks, gloves, screens, etc.), which enabled us to continue our work in the warehouse.

## "ESPRINT SOLIDARI"

### Campaign by Òmnium Cultural

At the end of March, Òmnium Cultural launched the **Esprint Solidari** (Solidarity Sprint) campaign, a huge countrywide marathon that became the common front of civil society, **to raise funds to help combat COVID and alleviate the effects of the serious health**, social and economic crisis associated with it. **The campaign raised €400,000**, which was split between four key organisations: the *Jo em corono* project, Hospital Clínic, the Col·legi de Metges and the Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona.



## "CAP LLAR SENSE ALIMENTS"

### Campaign by "la Caixa"

In April, the "la Caixa" Foundation and CaixaBank launched an emergency solidarity campaign for food banks to help alleviate the impact of COVID. Under the slogan **Cap llar sense aliments** (No Home Without Food), the "la Caixa" Foundation and CaixaBank created a **special action to help families in vulnerable situations during the first wave of COVID** and the strict lockdown. The campaign raised €700,000 for the four Catalan food banks.



## THE BANC DELS ALIMENTS OF BARCELONA SIGNS UP TO THE STRATEGIC FOOD PLAN OF CATALONIA (PEAC)

The Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona participated in a meeting organised by the Catalan Food Council with a view to consolidating the challenges of creating a **CATALAN FOOD SYSTEM: SUSTAINABLE – RESILIENT AND INNOVATIVE – COHESIVE – HEALTHY AND OF QUALITY**. 12 strategic axes will be derived from these 4 dimensions over the coming years.



# Highlights

## ENDESA DONATED €300,000 TO THE BANCS DELS ALIMENTS

to purchase basic products and to upgrade their logistics infrastructure



The COVID crisis gave rise to a huge show of solidarity for the food banks. One example of this came from **Endesa**, who has collaborated for many years with the food banks. The company wanted to show its commitment at this crucial time and donated 300,000 euros to facilitate the work of the four Catalan food banks, helping them to **stock their warehouses**. In a second phase, thanks to Endesa's donation, the four Catalan food banks were able to purchase electric and hybrid vehicles, thus allowing them to renew their fleet and use a more sustainable form of transport.

## GRANTS VIA THE GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA'S DARP PROGRAMME

The Department of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Food of the Generalitat de Catalunya established a grant scheme of 4 million euros, using European funds, to provide financial support to food producers affected by the loss of marketing channels and to help the sectors most affected by the economic and social crisis as well as the most vulnerable people in our society. The Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona was able to avail of the grant and received 616,000 kilos of local products including oil, milk, dairy products, meat and jams.

## "ALIMENTA" PROJECT

Barcelona City Council

During the de-escalation phase of the first wave, **Barcelona City Council** allocated 1 million euros to support, together with the social organisations in the city, **different food projects for vulnerable people**. The aim was to establish a model that would guarantee the right to adequate food and promote the autonomy and empowerment of citizens, **moving towards increasingly less welfarist models**.

In a second phase, the **City Council and the Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona** are working to implement a **new food model that can be reproduced in different areas of Barcelona**, which would be co-managed with social organisations and agents and involve different stakeholders in the city.

## COOKED MEALS

A collaboration with World Central Kitchen and other organisations



When the lockdown resulted in the closure of the social canteens, it became clear that a **distribution channel for prepared food had to be set up to meet the demand**. Several initiatives were launched to deliver cooked meals to the most vulnerable. These included **World Central Kitchen**, the well-known initiative of Chef **José Andrés**; **Food for Good**; **Comer Contigo**; **Ferrer For Food**, promoted by **La Vanguardia** newspaper and renowned chefs; **Valores Food**; and the **Formació i Treball** Foundation. Thanks to this network of collaborators **more than 217,000 cooked meals were delivered**.



## THE BANC DELS ALIMENTS OF BARCELONA WILL HAVE A VEHICLE FOR DISTRIBUTING FOOD

thanks to the collaboration of the "la Caixa" Foundation and Vallescar Automoció

The "la Caixa" Foundation and Vallescar Automoció, in collaboration with CaixaBank and CaixaBank Payments & Consumer, contributed a total of €31,100 so that the Banc dels Aliments of Barcelona could have a vehicle for carrying out its work in helping people in a situation of vulnerability. A new van was delivered to the food bank, which will facilitate food distribution among the social entities in the Barcelona area that are members of the food bank.

## THE FAMILY OF SOCIAL GROUP 'ONCE' DONATED 280,000 KGS OF FOOD TO FOOD BANKS ALL OVER SPAIN

The *Tones de Compromís* (Tonnes of Commitment) campaign managed to double its solidarity objective and delivered 7,000 kilos of basic products to the four Catalan food banks. Workers from ONCE, the ONCE Foundation and Ilunion, together with affiliates and the groups' entire family, took part in this huge initiative to collect non-perishable products so that many families wouldn't be left short of food as a result of the serious social imbalances caused by the pandemic.



## "CAP LLAR SENSE TORRÓ" Donation from Torrons Vicens



Torrons Vicens, a company based in Agramunt that makes artisan 'torró' (nougat), donated 50,000 bars of torró to the Catalan food banks. Under the slogan *Cap llar sense torró* (No Home Without Torró), the company distributed 22,500 kgs of torró to all vulnerable families in Catalonia over Christmas.

## "BIBERÓ SOLIDARI" CAMPAIGN Catalunya Ràdio and Palau Robert

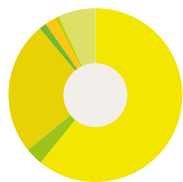


In December, Catalunya Ràdio's *El matí* programme, together with the Banc dels Aliments, launched a campaign to help children, with an installation entitled *Biberó Solidari* (Solidarity Baby Bottle). Donations were collected up until 24 December and were used to buy food for babies and children.

Palau Robert became a space for reflection on the changing society that COVID-19 has left us, a new reality that is undergoing continuous reinvention. The installation of a giant baby bottle served as a lure for people to make donations via a QR code that also allowed people to listen to the stories of those in a crisis situation as a result of COVID.

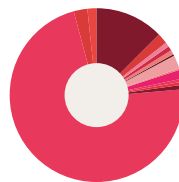
