PRESIDENT OF THE BANC DELS ALIMENTS DE BARCELONA

This is my first letter as president of the Banc dels Aliments. In March 2022, after years of dedicated work and in the spirit of renewal, Roser Brutau stepped down from the role of president of her own accord, but will continue at the Foundation as vice-president. Another key change was the appointment of Bosco Fonts as director. It was healthy year of changeover of positions, which is desirable in all organisations.

In **2022**, the Banc dels Aliments distributed 21 million kilos of products and provided vouchers and wallet cards worth more than 400,000 euros for the direct purchase of food. With the exception of last year, these are the largest amounts of food and financial aid that we have ever distributed.

This year was also characterised by various significant events that affected our work. I outline some of these below

Firstly, it is now evident that the new poverty caused by the COVID pandemic has become chronic. Once again, a part of the population affected by this poverty have been unable to emerge from it, and by the end of the year we were distributing food to **24,000**

more **people** than before the pandemic.

This problem was further compounded by a series of events that led to an increase in prices: the transport crisis, the fuel crisis, and the war in Ukraine. There has been a significant rise in the cost of living, especially with regard to food prices, which **increased by 15.7%**

All of these events have had a huge impact on family budgets, with a clear loss of purchasing power. The violation of the right to a healthy diet is becoming more widespread among families at risk of poverty. The consequences of all of this will be felt with greater intensity over the coming months.

This year we distributed fewer food products than we had planned, due to the increase in prices upsetting our food-buying budget. **We spent 840,803 euros more** that we would have at 2021 prices.

Our Gran Recapte campaign, which was on hold for two years because of the pandemic, was finally resumed this year. We received food donations in some establishments, as well as money donations that allowed us to pur-

chase and distribute food. Donations were made at the checkouts in supermarkets or directly via our website.

Once again, we witnessed the strength and capacity for mobilisation of both citizens and volunteers during this solidarity activity that means so much in Catalonia. We also saw that the value of the food donations was much higher than that of the money donations.

This year we distributed fewer food products due to the increase in prices upsetting our budget. We spent €840,803 more than we would have at 2021 prices.

Another key event in 2022 was the opening in February of the new warehouse, Foodback (Mercabarna **Food** Reuse Centre). This purpose of this new centre is to recover food that the wholesale companies at Mercabarna exclude from the commercial circuit. After a careful selection, many of these foods are deemed suitable for human consumption.

This is a pioneering project in Spain, and has been supported by all the public entities and institutions listed in this Report.

The Banc dels Aliments, as coordinator of Foodback, is in charge of distributing the food. Mercabarna handles the reception of the food and Formació i Treball manages a team of workers in the labour insertion programme who sort the food.

For our 35th anniversary we held an exhibition about food waste and the importance of guaranteeing the right to a healthy diet for all.

This year we also celebrated our **35th anniversary** by holding an exhibition in Palau Robert –with the Palau's support– entitled *Todo lo que no se come. 35 años aprovechando alimen-*

tos de manera solidaria (Everything that is not eaten. 35 years reusing food in social solidarity). The exhibition was centred around

food waste, the importance of guaranteeing the right to a healthy diet for all, and the environmental, social and healthy

environmental, social and health consequences of poor dietary habits.

It provided the perfect opportunity to explain to citizens the work involved in recovering the food and how it contributes to reducing the environmental impact that destroying this food would entail.

We have also made great strides in improving the efficiency of our logistics, by decentralising it to make it more accessible to the regional entities outside Barcelona. The warehouse in Manresa, managed by the Convent de Santa Clara Foundation, was optimised, and platforms were contracted in Maresme and Vallès Occi-

This improvement helped to reduce the transport costs of the social entities receiving the food, and to decrease traffic in the city of Barcelona, resulting in an estimated saving of around 79,0000 km in transport.

I would like to conclude by thanking the **staff and volunteers** at the Banc dels Aliments for their enormous effort and for helping us to achieve the results we

> set out in this Annual Report, and also citizens, companies and public institutions for their support.

And to especially thank the **331 social entities** we distribute the food to, for

the work they do with vulnerable people referred to them by social services. Not only do they distribute the food, they also provide invaluable support and, in many cases, help with social and labour insertion. It is they who give meaning to the Banc dels Aliments

SUPPORT FOR ENTITIES

Food distribution offers access to aid until the right to food is guaranteed for all citizens. The Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona (Barcelona Food Bank) promotes a distribution model that is:

SUSTAINABLE

Transport is coordinated in order to reduce the carbon footprint. We promote the collection of surplus food from local markets, supermarkets and restaurants and the consumption of fresh fruit and vegetables. Food collected during the Gran Recapte campaign in the various regions is distributed directly.



FEEICIENT

We monitor, support and advise the recipient entities, encourage collaboration among the entities via the network, and connect them with municipal social services. We support entity groupings and promote regulatory warehouses and free-choice food models.



Food is distributed via seven different distribution programmes according to the type and origin of the food, applying different distribution criteria and taking into consideration the number of people assisted who have been referred by social services. Distribution is carried out equitably to ensure that all beneficiaries receive a similar variety and quantity food.



INCLUSIVE

60% of all the recipient entities also offer support, guidance and advice for social and labour inclusion. We promote a free-choice model to ensure dignified food distribution. This model generates indirect employment in logistics, transport, administration and the social sector. It also fosters citizen participation through volunteering.

THE BANC DELS ALIMENTS

We ensure the proper functioning and compliance with the commitment to action signed by each of the entities, by means of an acceptance process based on our requirements and through regular monitoring and support visits to all the entities.

MORE THAN 109,000 MEALS COOKED EACH MONTH

A few years ago, a new initiative was born as a result of activities carried out during the pandemic, and which is of great benefit to other entities and their registered beneficiaries.

There are now four recipient entities who cook meals for other entities, located in different towns in the province of Barcelona: the Ferrer Sustainability Foundation, in Vilassar de Dalt; the Formació i Treball Foundation, in Sant Adrià de Besós; the

Dr. Melchor Colet Foundation, in Esplugues de Llobregat; and the Tochete Foundation, in Sant Just Desvern.

Between these four solidarity kitchens, around 109,090 meals a month were cooked with products supplied, in part, by the Banc dels Aliments. The meals were cooked at the premises of each Foundation and then distributed to the 65 entities who, in turn, distributed them to people in a situation of vulnerability.



this 14th edition was a combination of the interactive physical collection of food donations with money donations.

475,985 € IN VOUCHERS AND WALLET CARDS

In 2022, in addition to providing almost 21 million kilos of food to those in need, the Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona also provided financial aid worth €475,985 to social entities for the purchase of staple foods. This aid was split into:

- 7,251 wallet cards worth €271,120 distributed in coordination with CÁRITAS, RED CROSS CATALONIA and other collaborating organisations, to people in a situation of poverty, allowing them to buy food products according to their needs and preferences.
- Vouchers worth €204,865 given to social entities to exchange for food in supermarkets, local shops and municipal markets.

LOGISTICS

The Logistics Department receives the food, stores it, and distributes it to the social entities. It establishes a series of delivery routes to facilitate the distribution of fresh, chilled and frozen products.

DISTRIBUTION

The Distribution Department establishes the food delivery programmes according to the characteristics and attributes of each product (dry, fresh, chilled/ frozen, dietary food, etc.) and the number of people assisted by each entity, ensuring a fair and equitable distribution in compliance with food safety regulations.

ENTITIES

The entities are classified according to how they provide the food (consumption -soup kitchens, children's breakfasts and snacks, nursing homes and social housing - and distribution: food parcels or freechoice). It also depends on the entity's consumption or distribution capacity, and availability of facilities for storing and conserving chilled or frozen food.

The Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona was set up 35 years ago to tackle the problem of food waste and to help guarantee the right to an adequate and healthy diet for people in its environment. It works towards achieving 6 of the United Nations' sustainable development goals (SDGs).

By food waste, we mean food that is lost or discarded alona the food chain, from production, processing and transport to distribution, restaurants and homes.

In 2022, the Banc dels Aliments recovered, before the expiry date, 10,650,000 kilos of food fit for human consumption, from the following areas:

Commemorative exhibition for the **35th anniversary** of the Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona

To mark the 35th anniversary of its creation, the Banc dels Aliments held an explanatory exhibition in Hall 4 of Palau Robert, from 4 July to 28 August. The exhibition was entitled **"Todo lo que no se come. 35 años aprovechando alimentos de manera solidaria"** (Everything that is not eaten. 35 years reusing food in social solidarity).

Organised by the Directorate-General for Dissemination in collaboration with Aigües de Barcelona, the exhibition was centred around two key pillars of the BdA's activities: fighting against systemic food waste, by reusing food, and helping to guarantee the right to a healthy diet for all.

In addition, a food truck was installed near one of the entrances to Palau Robert. It was managed by the staff of the Formació i Treball Foundation, and offered free juices made from products recovered from Mercabarna's FOODBACK facility.

Food waste varies according to the geographical area of the world and is caused by many factors. The main factor is the production of surplus food, which occurs for different reasons, such as difficulty with forecasting and managing stock, packaging issues, labelling and storage, climate conditions and consumer behaviour: buying too much, rejecting imperfect products, generating leftovers, and confusing the best before date with the expiry date.



To be able to feed yourself: a human right.



A vast amount of food waste occurs throughout the entire food chain. According to FAO figures, 2,460 tonnes of food are thrown away every minute, worldwide, which is a third of the total produced for human consumption.

Feeding ourselves is fundamental for our survival. It is a human right and, as such, is included in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of 1948. It is estimated that more than 700 million people currently go hungry.

In our environment, the right to food is not guaranteed for a large part of the population, since they have no way of accessing an adequate and healthy diet. In its Household Budget Survey, the Spanish National Statistics Institute (INE) states that 20% of the population spends €3.5 a day on feeding themselves, which is clearly not enough for a necessary diet.

An insufficient and unhealthy diet has known consequences for our health. Hyper-caloric diets, with an excess of sugars and fats and a lack of plant fibre, among others, cause high blood pressure, cholesterol, overweight and diabetes and favour the development of many types of cancers. An unhealthy diet is one of the main causes of a high percentage of diseases.

In recent years, people have started to show signs of increasing awareness of the need to combat food waste. The deterioration of our environment, due to various factors such as overpopulation, climate crisis, reduced water and energy resources and unsustainable food production models, as well as the excessive increase in food prices, indicates that the way in which we currently feed ourselves will not be the same in the immediate future.

The Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona was created in 1987

The Banc dels Aliments (BdA) was created in 1987 with the aim of recovering surplus food and distributing it to people in a situation of poverty. The Brundtland Report was published in this same year, which laid the foundation for sustainable development, the first time this term was used.

For 35 years the Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona, with a highly visionary perspective, has been fighting against food waste and helping to guarantee the right to a healthy diet. Two problems that, almost four decades later, still exist in our environment.

The aim of this exhibition was to address these issues through a series of everyday actions that make the visitor reflect on their relationship with food in the 21st century.

We live in a system that allows food to end up in a bin. Do you know if you are part of this process? Do you know what can be done to change this reality? We can begin by asking ourselves this question: what happens to everything that is not eaten?

These questions were answered at the exhibition in Palau Robert, organised by the Banc dels Aliments to mark its 35th anniversary.

On the initiative of the Director-General of Food, Quality and Agri-Food Industries, it has now

become an itinerant exhibition and can be seen in various locations throughout Catalonia in 2023.



FOODBACK

New Food Reuse Centre at Mercabarna

On 1 February, **FOODBACK**, a new **Food Reuse Centre at Mercabar- na** came into operation. This is a pioneering project for managing surplus food from wholesale markets in Spain and is a step forward in the fight against food waste.

The opening ceremony for FOOD-BACK was held on Wednesday 23 February and was presided over,

among other authority figures, by **Ada Colau**, the mayor of Barcelona, with the presence of **Teresa Jordà**, the Minister of Climate Action, Food and Rural Agenda.

The new facility is coordinated by the Banc dels Aliments. Mercabarna is responsible for filtering the entry of food, Formació i Treball for selecting the food, with the help of a team of **7 people in** **labour insertion programmes**, and the BdA for distributing the food among the registered social entities.

FOODBACK is located in a new 900 m² warehouse beside Mercabarna's Punto Verde (waste collection point), facilitating waste management for the wholesale companies at the market.

Giving food products a second life

FOODBACK is a key facility in the new management system for organic matter at Mercabarna, where the surplus fruit and vegetables provided by the wholesalers are sorted and selected, to give them a second life. After selection, the products that are suitable for human consumption are distributed to the social entities in our environment, so that they reach the people most in need.



In parallel to the direct distribution of fruit and vegetables from FOODBACK, food processing initiatives will be established in order to make the most of the surplus; for example, preparing meals for soup kitchens, making preserves, etc. It also collaborates with social initiatives related to food reuse.

The aim of this project is to have multiplied food reuse at Mercabarna by 2.5 within five years, increasing from the current 1,000-1,500 tonnes of products recovered to 3,000-4,000 tonnes.

Social and institutional collaboration

FOODBACK is one of the legacies of the Barcelona World Capital of Sustainable Food project, along with other projects submitted during 2022.

This project is supported by a group of organisations represented in the Strategic Commission. In addition to Mercabarna, the Banc dels Aliments and Forma-

ció i Treball, it has the collaboration of Assocome (Association of Mercabarna Companies) which includes 600 companies, Cáritas Diocesana de Barcelona, Red Cross Catalonia, the "Alimenta" programme promoted by Barcelona City Council, the Ministry of Climate Action, Food and Rural Agenda of the Generalitat

de Catalunya, and the "la Caixa" Foundation.

This is without doubt a pioneering programme –an example of the sum of efforts and public and private partnerships (SDG 17)—that contributes significantly to Agenda 2030 of the Sustainable Development Goals.

UKRAINE

The Banc dels Aliments coordinated the delivery of more than **463,000 kilos** of material to Ukraine

The outbreak of the war in Ukraine triggered a huge wave of solidarity among the population and resulted in the donation, via several initiatives, of different types of material goods. This caused a logistics problem in terms of how to channel the goods and ensure that they reach their destination.

At institutional level, and in agreement with the Ukrainian authorities, it was decided to set up a few logistics centres in the country to centralise and organise this humanitarian aid.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Generalitat, in collaboration with the Ukrainian Consulate, entrusted the Port of Barcelona with organising a logistics centre. For this purpose, the Port of Barcelona provided one of the available warehouses at ZAL and asked the Banc dels Aliments to manage and coordinate this logistics centre for humanitarian aid, to ensure that it reached the destinations specified by the Ukrainian Consulate. This type of aid was never actually promoted, due to financial aid being much more efficient.

Thanks to the contributions of associations and entities, a total

of 50 heavy goods lorries loaded with 463,517 kilos of medicines, hygiene products, food, clothing and footwear for adults and children were sent to the Ukrainian people.



The material was received in a 1,800 m2 warehouse made available by the Port of Barcelona, where the goods were centralised. Once they had been inventoried and properly packaged, the deliveries to Ukraine were organised.

The Banc dels Aliments provided the means and personnel necessary to ensure the functioning of this logistics centre, and had the valuable support of volunteers from the Banc dels Aliments itself, the Port of Barcelona and the Cares Foundation. Open Arms organised the first deliveries and also provided volunteers.

The SEPLA Ayuda Foundation, a union for airline pilots in Spain, also collaborated in the project, enabling some of the deliveries to be made by air, by taking advantage of the cargo space of planes flying to neighbouring countries. SEUR also participated in this project, making various contributions.

Many entities and people contributed to helping the Ukrainian people, including SEUR, the Cares Foundation with their selfless collaboration, and that of the employees and dockers at the Port of Barcelona, who coordinated the goods and loaded and unloaded the lorries.

The project was supported by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and ran until 31 December.





LOGISTICAL EFFICIENCY

New regional food distribution centres

In 2022, the Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona consolidated the project for new food distribution centres, to centralise and optimise logistics. This initiative has a dual aim: to minimise the environmental impact caused by the multitude of vehicles used by the social entities to distribute the food, and to help the regional entities to reduce their transport costs.

The project involved decentralising food delivery by optimising or creating three intermediary warehouses in Cabrera de Mar, Santa Perpètua de Mogoda and Manresa, thus avoiding transit through Barcelona city.

A total of 77 entities (in the 8 Catalan regions) registered with the warehouses and collected food from these new centres, saving a total journey of 9,031 km a month.

- Cabrera de Mar: supplies 19 entities in the Maresme region, who distribute 76,769 kg of food a month to 16,617 people
- Santa Perpètua de Mogoda: supplies 14 entities in Vallès Occidental and 20 in Vallès Oriental, who distribute 92,710 kg of food a month to 7,336 people
- Manresa: an optimised warehouse supplying 77 entities in the Bages, Berguedà, Moianès,

Osona and Anoia regions, who distribute 46,580 kg of food a month (including dry products, SERMA fruit and vegetables, chilled and frozen products) to 11,849 people

These warehouses are in addition to those that were already operational in some cities, such as Sabadell and Terrassa.

The BdA delivers the food to people within a 100 km radius of service through a network of 310 social entities in the province of Barcelona. This intense activity carried out by our warehouses requires significant logistical coordination.

Each year we distribute around 20 million kilos of food, more than half of which is recovered food. An average of 140,000 people a month benefit from this food.

The decrease in transport saves fuel, reduces staff costs and improves the environmen-

tal impact by reducing CO2 emissions. Facilitating the distribution of food for the entities and enabling delivery in refrigerated transport helps maintain the nutrient content of the food.

Since 1987, the Banc dels Aliments de Barcelona has worked determinedly to help prevent food waste and to contribute to guaranteeing a healthy diet for people in a situation of poverty.

CSW RECOGNITION

Commendation from the Department of Justice of the Generalitat de Catalunya



On 22 September, the Department of Justice of the Generalitat de Catalunya awarded a certificate publicly recognising the work of the Banc dels Aliments'

in providing appropriate activities for carrying out Community Service Work (CSW), based on a collaboration agreement signed by both parties.

The certificate was presented by the Minister of Justice, Lourdes Ciuró, to Lluís Fatjó-Vilas, President of the Foundation, at a public ceremony held at the Palacio de Pedralbes.

The Agreement establishes the terms and conditions governing appropriate public and social interest activities in relation to tasks carried out at the Banc dels Aliments by individuals assigned by the Department of

Justice as part of the Community Service Work programme.

The commendation recognises the Banc dels Aliments' efforts over the years to involve these individuals, together with salaried staff and volunteers, in the day-to-day tasks in the warehouse.



COLLECTION OF SURPLUS FOOD

25,230 kilos of food recovered from Alimentaria and Seafood Expo Global

This year again, the Banc dels Aliments carried out two impact activities to the recover surplus food generated during the ALIMENTARIA and SEAFOOD EXPO GLOBAL trade fairs held in Barcelona.

Thanks to donations from the participating companies at these two fairs, we **recovered a total of 25,230 kilos of premium-quality food with high nutritional value:** dry, fresh and frozen products (ALIMENTARIA) and fresh and frozen fish and seafood (SEAFOOD EXPO GLOBAL). The food was distributed among various soup kitchens and social entities.



The BdA deployed **a team of 120** volunteers who made this important food recovery activity possible. They visited the various stands

at the two trade fairs to recover the products, using a logistical device for rapid collection and transfer to the Banc dels Aliments' central warehouse.

The BdA thanks ALIMENTARIA for its support and for facilitating our attendance at the trade fair, and the donating companies for their cooperation. We also thank SEA-FOOD EXPO GLOBAL for raising awareness and informing the participants about the importance of donating food surplus in order to avoid waste and to help complete the diet of the people assisted by the Banc dels Aliments.
